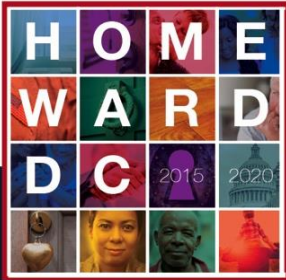
Scope of Advisory Team

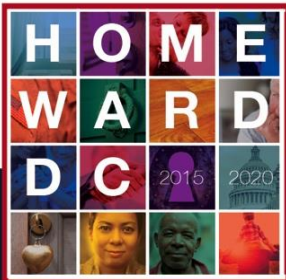

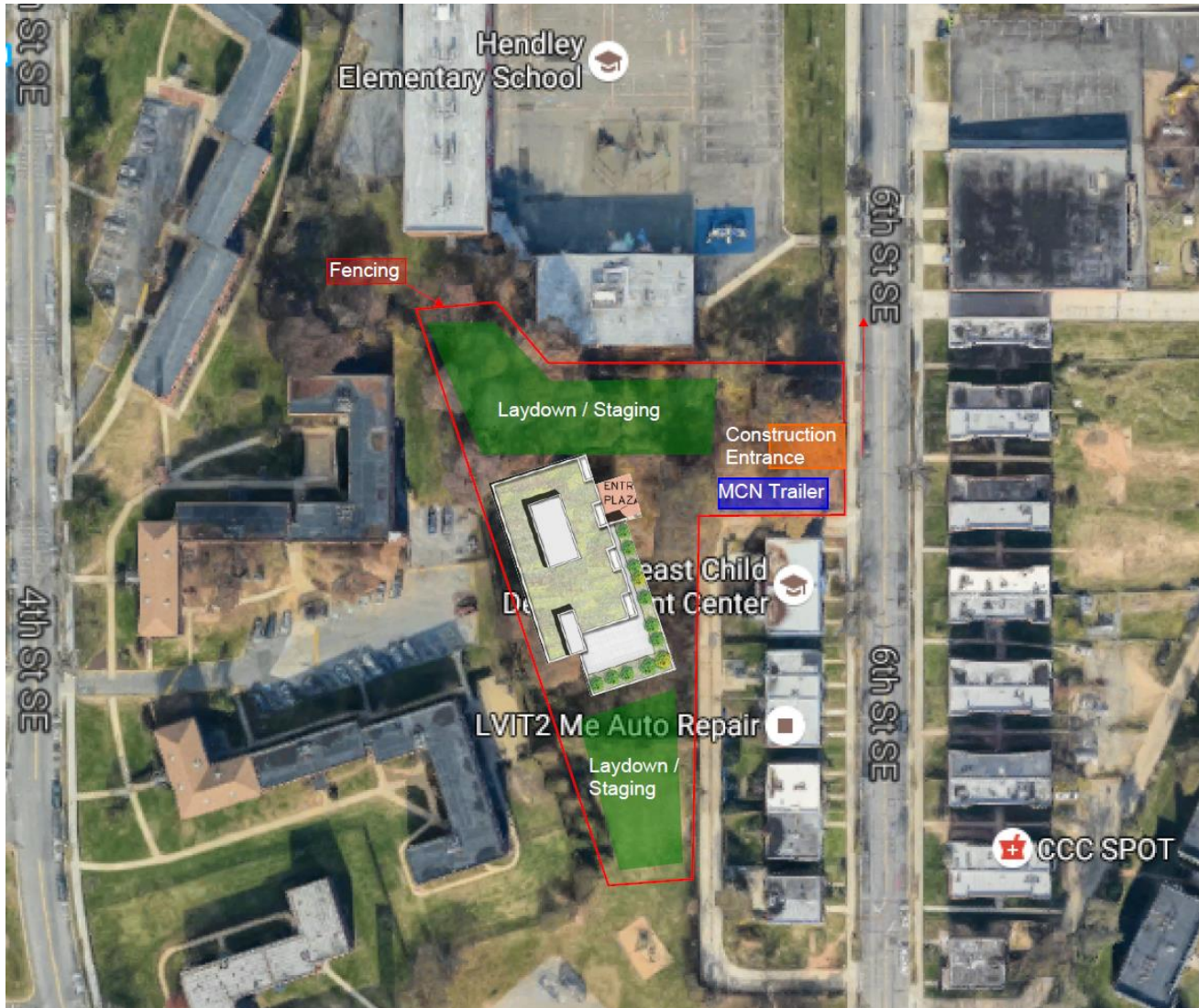
