The Cold Emergency Alert will be Activated

The District will operate under a Cold Emergency meaning that additional services and supports are available to help homeless residents. Please note that due to the amount of snow expected, No warming buses will be in operation, additional warming sites will be opened. Extra outreach will commence today to bring homeless individuals to safe and warm facilities before transport becomes dangerous. Staff will be present at the former warming bus locations to inform, direct and request transport for homeless individuals to other warming site locations. Please note, end times indicated below will be adjusted based on the status of the DC Government being open, open with delay, or closed. Should DC Government be closed tomorrow, the shelter and warming sites will be open 24 hours.
