The District will operate under a Cold Emergency meaning that additional services and supports are available to help homeless residents. Please note that due to the amount of snow on the streets, **No warming buses will be in operation, additional warming sites will be opened.** Please note, end times indicated below will be adjusted based on the status of the DC Government being open:

- If DC Government is open on time shelters/warming sites close at normal time of 7:00 am
- If DC Government has delayed opening shelters/warming sites extend closing by one or two hours
- If DC Government is closed shelters/warming sites will remain open 24 hours
